Errata for Shattered Armada

Page 16, Change the caption title from “Nationalist gunboat Eduarto Dato” to “Nationalist gunboat Eduardo Dato”

Page A-7, Spanish *Calvo Sotelo* class has a 4 in/45 MkL, not 4 in/40

Page A-8, Spanish *Cánovas Del Castillo* class has a 4 in/45 MkL, not 4 in/40

Page A-9, Spanish *Ciriza* class PG. The arc for the Nordenfelt 6 pdr gun is A (aft).

Page A-9, Spanish *Galerna* class PG. The arcs for the 4 in/50 guns are F/A, and for the 6 pdr/8 cwt P/S.

Page B-3, Italian Fiat CR.32 has an inline pistorn engine, not a radial engine.

Page C-1, French Hotchkiss 7mm Mle 1922. The data for the gun is missing. The values are:

Page C-3, Spanish Vickers 76.2mm/45 Mod SS: The Medium range damage value is 9, not 0.

Page C-5, Annex C4 AA Guns. The Vickers 4 inch MkL gun is 4 in/45, not 4 in/40
